THE AIM OF THE LEISURE CARD SCHEME

is for all children and young people in Kvam to feel like they have a place they belong to where they can learn new skills. The Leisure Card is a pilot project run by the Norwegian Directorate for Children, Youth and Family Affairs and will continue until spring 2022 inclusive.

GET STARTED WITH THE LEISURE CARD:

The Leisure Card is digital and you can find it at kvam.friskus.com.

You must register **before** you pay.

On the website, you will also find an overview of all the activities that are available to children and young people in Kvam.

Pay for activities at: kvam.friskus.com/fritidskortet Or **scan the QR code**. You use the Leisure Card to pay, but you must sign up directly with the person organising the leisure activity. If the fee exceeds the amount on the Leisure Card, you must pay the excess amount yourself. If you cannot afford to pay the excess, you can contact Kristin Lundblad about the Leisure Card Plus.
